## ADVISORY

In line with the new testing and quarantine protocols issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) embodied under IATF Resolution No. 144-A and 144-B (s.2021), all airlines are advised to adopt and perform the following tasks and procedures for all international arriving flights at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport:


- Require 100% passenger registration in the One Health Pass (OHP)
- Check hotel bookings, transportation arrangement, RT-PCR test arrangement
- Check country of origin classification (Red, Yellow, Green) and the quarantine requirements
- Check health documents (Vaccination Certificates, RT PCR test results, OEC for OFWs, Seamans Book etc.
- Conduct Inflight briefing on arrival protocols
- Coordinate medical repatriation with the BOQ

All airlines shall also inform their passengers of the foregoing procedures, and ensure passenger compliance with the requirements, such as testing, hotel, and registration with the OHP before boarding the flight.

Non-compliance with the foregoing shall be dealt with appropriate sanction in accordance with the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-01 dated 08 January 2021, and other relevant rules, laws, and regulations.
