If you have recently been in the United Kingdom, South Africa, Brazil or Norway

If you have traveled to Sweden from the UK, South Africa, Brazil or Norway in the last 14 days you must stay at home while you wait to be tested for COVID-19 and until you have received the results. It is recommended that you take your first test immediately upon arrival in Sweden from the United Kingdom, South Africa, Brazil or Norway, and another test on the fifth day after your arrival. Please note that this testing only is suitable for travellers from the United Kingdom, South Africa, Brazil and Norway and is therefore not suitable for other people who need to be tested for ongoing covid-19 infection.

You must stay at home for at least seven days after your arrival in Sweden. This also applies to children who would otherwise attend school or preschool. During this whole period, you must avoid coming into close contact with others, and you must wash your hands frequently and carefully.

If you live together with others who have not been in the United Kingdom, in South Africa, Brazil or Norway, they should also stay at home until you have received your test results, and this also applies to preschool- and school-age children.

If you test positive for COVID-19, your healthcare provider will inform you of the steps you must take in order to avoid the risk of infecting others.
